Overview

The Asterisk Phonebook module allows you to create system-wide speed dial numbers that can be dialed from any phone. Using speed dial codes requires entering the feature code for speed dial, which is *0 by default. For example, if the speed dial code is 100, then you would dial *0100 to use it. (See the Feature Codes module user guide for information about changing feature codes).

Logging In

• Log into the Asterisk Phonebook module and you should see a screen like this. Below will be a list of all your phonebook entries. You can edit or delete any of these entries or add new ones.

Use this module to create system wide speed dial numbers that can be dialed from any phone.

Creating a Phonebook Entry

Submit Changes

- For each phonebook entry, you can define the following:
 - Name- Enter a personal or business name.
 - **Number** Enter the number to be dialed. For caller ID to work, it should match the caller ID received from the network.
 - **Speed dial code** Enter a speed dial code. The Speed Dial module must be enabled to use these codes.
 - **Set Speed Dial** Check this toggle to have the speed dial code automatically created. If you enter a speed dial code, checking this will have no effect.
 - In the example, the entry is for "Hollywood Towing," their number is "16045551212" and I want the speed dial code to be "100."

• After you press "Submit Changes," you should see a screen like this. **Note** that the current phonebook can be exported.

Import from CSV

- A list of phonebook entries can be imported as a CSV file when the following format is used: "Hollywood Towing";16045551212;100 with one entry per line. **Note** the "Name" and the ';' field separator.
- Simply choose the CSV file and press the "Upload" button.
